What are the benefits of leading a troop?

What qualifications do I need to be a troop leader?

You should:

- enjoy working with girls.
- subscribe to the beliefs and values of Girl Scouting and register as a member.
- be at least 18 years old, display maturity and the ability to lead girls toward independent behavior.

When and where do troops meet?

- Troops meet when and as often as is allowed by the girl's and leader's schedule – weekly, twice a month, or special events.
- After school, on weekends, or evenings.
- Troops meet in schools, churches or homes. Local Service Teams can assist troops with meeting space requirements.

What support can I expect as a leader?

- Leaders are provided with materials such as a Program Guide, Leader Resource Guide, and more.
- Local and council programs and events are offered to enhance regular troop activities.
- Girl Scouts of Rolling Hills Council maintains and operates Camp Agnes DeWitt for outdoor experiences.
